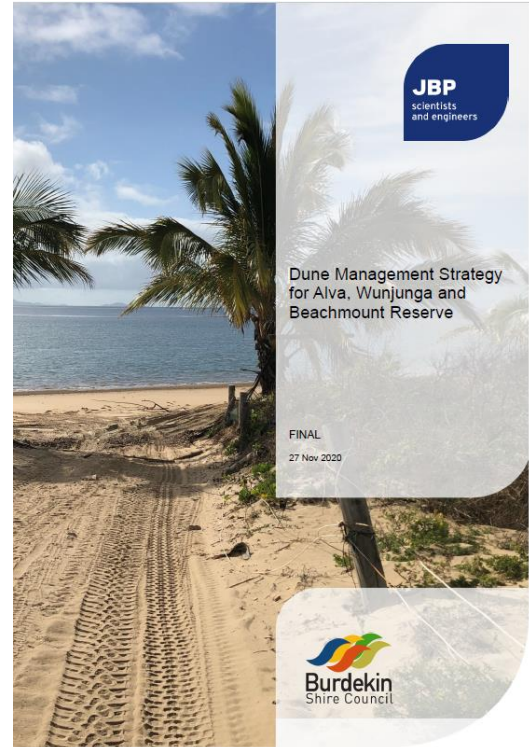


Wunjunga Dune Protection Works

Background

- 2020 developed Dune Management Strategy
- 2021- 2022 revegetation works commenced in Alva
- 2023 – 2024 works commenced in Wunjunga –
QCoast ₂₁₀₀ grant
 - Revegetation – 2 zones
 - Signs
 - Fencing







Program Overview

- 3 nurseries – 2,345 stems
- Site A – 0.3 Ha – 1,450 stems, planted late November 2023
- Site B – 0.2 Ha – 890 stems, planted December 2023 (Community Planting Day)

- Fencing: Site A – 1.5km
- Fencing: Site B – to be completed

- Signs: finalised – waiting for quotes





PROTECTING THE WUNJUNGA DUNES



The dunes to the south of Wunjunga are a known turtle nesting area for up to five species of turtles.

Protect the dunes and wildlife by:

- ✪ Driving below the high tide
- ✪ Driving on the beach or approved tracks only



REMEMBER: Look out for other beach users including children, walkers, vehicles and animals.

PROTECTING THE DUNES WHEN BEACH DRIVING



- ✪ Drive below the high tide line
- ✪ Drive on the beach or approved roads/tracks only
- ✪ Stay off the dunes to protect the nests of turtles and birds
- ✪ Watch for other beach users including children and animals
- ✪ Drive to the conditions
- ✪ Follow the road rules
- ✪ **REMEMBER:** Watch the tides, plan your trip and return home safely.
